

Thank you for choosing us as your healthcare provider during such an important time in your life, having a baby is very exciting but can also be very expensive. We have provided some financial information on pregnancy billing for your future reference.

Pregnancy is billed as a global fee, which means, the routine prenatal visits are grouped together with our delivery portion and your post-partum visit with us. That global fee is not billed out until after you have had your baby, it will be billed as the date of service you deliver your baby. This is why you won't be required to pay copays each time you come into the office; however, you may be asked to pay one when you have an ultrasound.

# Please Read Carefully:

- ✓ While you are an OB patient if you see our providers for non-OB related visits, it will be billed separate from your global fee. (Co-payment(s) or Co-Insurance may apply.)
- ✓ An outside laboratory will bill you for your OB Panel (done in 1<sup>st</sup> trimester), you will pay that outside lab (possibly Labcorp) directly.
- ✓ Any Lab/Blood tests or Ultrasounds will be billed separately (paid on/within 45 days).
- ✓ Hospital Admits, Exams/Consults and Epidurals are billed separately.
- ✓ Charges may vary if you change insurance companies at any time during pregnancy.
- ✓ Charges may vary if your insurance benefits change at any time during pregnancy.
- ✓ Insured patients without maternity coverage will only receive self-pay discounts for Women's Center bills. Labs or other services will not be discounted.

Every OB patient (excluding Medicaid patients) is required to pre-pay towards their global fee, prior to their delivery and pre-payments do vary depending on insurance coverage.

- For a vaginal delivery, you can expect to pre-pay between \$1,000 \$372.90
- For a C-Section delivery, you can expect to pre-pay between \$1,500 \$467
- For a VBAC delivery, you can expect to pre-pay between \$1,000 \$393.40

If you are SELF-PAY, we will come up with a pre-payment plan that works for you. Self-pay patients do get a 30% discount when they pay the global fee in full, prior to delivery.

\*\*Self-pay patients must pay the <u>same day</u> for the following services in order to get 30% discount: Labs, Urine cultures, TDAP, Rhogam, NST's, ultrasounds. \*\*

### **Price Estimates for Obstetrical Care**

### Pregnancy 'GLOBAL' pricing

Normal OB Care with Vaginal Delivery \$4,000 OB Care with Cesarean Delivery \$5,390

OB Care with Vaginal Birth After Previous C-Section \$5,102 Cesarean Assistant Fee \$924.50

#### The 'Global' is billed at the end of the pregnancy and includes the following:

All <u>Regular</u> Routine Obstetrical Office Visits, Delivery and Postpartum Visit(s) (Up to 6 weeks after the delivery / any visits after the 6 weeks may have an additional charge.)

## Services NOT included in the 'Global' fee for your pregnancy.

- While you are pregnant, if you see our providers for non-OB related visits, it may be billed separate from your global fee.
- An outside lab will bill you for your OB Panel, urine culture, Glucose test, Iron screen and Group B strep culture.
- RH negative patients will also need an antibody screen that will be billed by an outside lab.
- Any additional labs ordered throughout your pregnancy will be billed through an outside lab.
- Prenatal genetic testing (optional) billed through outside lab.

Follow-up ultrasound (cpt 76816)	\$321
Fetal Non-Stress Test (cpt 59025)	\$99
Rhogam (cpt J2790) Medication injection (cpt 96372)	\$173
3D Ultrasound (Elective, must pay same day done between 28-32wks)	\$100
